The students will have their own supplies, no sharing. Students will be at tables and moderately distanced to the best of our ability,

Students will be spaced as distanced as is possible in our space. We do not guarantee 6 feet of separation at all times.

Masks are not required, but are welcomed if a parent would like to make sure their student is wearing one, we will do our best to help them keep it on.

If your student would like to carry their personal hand sanitizer, that is great.

We will also have sanitizer for students to use. As long as we are able to keep a supply.

We did split the group into two lunch groups to allow a bit more space. The lunch tables will be cleaned and sanitized each day and between lunch periods as well.

Our sanitization, germicidal spray, and wipes will continue after the students leave the building and before they get there... (that has always been normal at ITL especially during "flu season" so we are just doing that year round).

We will encourage a lot of good handwashing. Between classes and lunch.

At this time and until the County Health Dept or mayor of Peculiar MANDATES anything differently, we will just use one entrance, and no temps at the door...

We do ask families to please KEEP YOUR CHILD HOME if they have a fever. Please be 48 hours FEVER FREE before returning to class.

This will be the case regardless of what the local school system does. We do want the students and teachers to be in an environment good for learning and to be able to share stories and lessons, not germs! So we will do everything we can to make that happen.
